

Member-Guest Tournament

Tournament Format & Rules



Format:

This year's format will be a quota system event with each player gaining points based on their score for each hole. On the first day, each team's assigned quota will be based on the players' handicaps. Following the first round and second round each team's assigned quota will be adjusted 75% up for every point they exceed their assigned quota and 50% down for every point below their assigned quota.

For example, should a team have a first round quota of 36 points and then go out and make 40 points, their score would be +4 after the first day. The adjusted quota starting in the second day would be 39 points. On the other hand, if they made only 30 points, their score would be -6 after the first day. The adjusted quota starting on the second day would be 33 points. All quotas will be rounded up to determine the next day's quota. Points will be awarded on a gross basis as follows:

Points will be awarded as follows:

Bogey: 1 point Par: 2 points Birdie: 4 points Eagle: 6 points Double Eagle/Ace: 8 points

Weather:

The Committee may suspend play in the event of hazardous weather. Rain alone does not constitute grounds for suspending play. Perry Weather will alert all players if play is to be suspended. In the event of hazardous weather, 27 holes will constitute a tournament. Teams that have accumulated the most points in their flight over 27 holes will be declared the flight winners.

Player Auction:

This year's Player Auction will follow an open-bid format with the auctioning of teams on Wednesday night. The minimum opening bid for a team is \$400.00. The Player's Auction is lively and fast-paced, so pay close attention to ensure you have the opportunity to purchase the team(s) of your choice. Each team will be individually sold to the highest bidder; however, the owner must allow up to 50% of the team to be sold to actual team members if they choose to do so. This transaction must be completed prior to the start of the first round of competition.

Players, not the tournament committee, will be responsible for handling this transaction. Payment for each team is **CASH ONLY**. Payouts will be made by flight, based on 54 holes of Team Quota.* Ties will be split.

Player Auction Payout:

Teams will receive the following percentages from the money collected in their flight:

• Flight Winner: 50%

• 2nd Place: 30%

• 3rd Place: 20%

Shoot Out – \$2,000.00 Added

At the conclusion of the 3-day Tournament Quota play, the following teams will qualify for the Shootout Tournament, hosted on Green 9:

- Each flight winner (6 teams)
- One randomly drawn team from the entire field
- The team with the highest Quota score that did not win their flight

Tie Breaker: In the event of a tie, qualification will be determined by:

- The team's total score on Day 3, Hole 18
- If still tied, scores will be compared sequentially starting with the lowest handicapped hole on Day 3, then proceeding to the next lowest handicapped hole, and so on until the tie is broken.

The Shootout will follow an alternate shot format and feature 8 teams. The elimination format will proceed as follows:

- The field will start with 8 teams and reduce to 4.
- The 4 remaining teams will be reduced to 2.
- The final 2 teams will compete to determine the Shootout winner.

Payout:

1st place: \$1,5002nd place: \$500

In the event of a tie, the tie will be resolved by either a putting or chipping competition, as determined by Director of Golf, Larry Muskopf. 1st and 2nd place will be decided by alternate shot stroke play and will continue until there is an outright winner.

Automatic Qualification for Member Guest 2026:

Starting in 2025, not all participants in The Heath Member Guest will automatically qualify for the following year's tournament. This change is intended to provide additional opportunities for new members and others on the growing Alternate List. The Heath consists of 6 flights, with 8 teams in each flight.

To automatically qualify for next year's Member Guest Tournament, your team must place in the top 6 in your flight. If your team places 7th or 8th, you will be placed on the alternate list for the following year and enter a lottery for any available spots.

Any ties to determine the automatic qualifiers will be broken based on the total quota points on day three. If ties remain, they will be decided by both players' scores on hole 18 on day three.
